

Work with Landlords through BBP

The Better Buildings Partnership (BBP) is an exclusive collaboration of London's leading commercial property owners and allied organisations, supported by the Mayor of London and the London Development Agency, whose aim is to develop solutions to enable the commercial property sector to take up widespread sustainable building retrofit and achieve substantial carbon savings in London's existing commercial building stock.

The BBP complements the Green500 by addressing how commercial Landlords can improve the environmental performance of their buildings and work with the tenants who occupy them to jointly reduce consumption and CO₂ emissions.

The BBP has set up an Owner Occupier Working Group for Green500 and BBP representatives to discuss how they can work in partnership to improve their operational performance, learn from best practise initiatives and gain a greater understanding of upcoming legislation such as EPCs, DECs and CRC. The BBP is calling for any Green500 members who have an interest in working with their landlord to jointly improve the environmental performance to contact the BBP and take part in the working group.
